



With a wingspan of almost three meters and weighing in at over 10 kg, the Dalmatian pelican is one of the most impressive breeding birds in Europe. It's an ambassador for healthy and well connected wetlands and an iconic species of the Danube delta. Dalmatian pelican is globally threatened and needs protection.



Conservation of the Dalmatian pelican along the Black-Sea Mediterranean Flyway project (“Pelican Way of LIFE”) is the principal conservation project for the Dalmatian pelican (*Pelecanus crispus*) in Europe and at global scale. It aims to reduce the threats to the birds and improve their habitat at 27 Natura 2000 sites in Romania, Bulgaria, Greece and Ukraine.
